
De-listing search-engine content concerning me

European residents can contact search engines to request de-listing of web content relating to their surnames and first names.

De-indexing does not result in deletion of source content.



- 1 Contact the search engine via the dedicated form or by post
- Justify your request:

 «The content connected with [this URL]
 concerns me as it is related to:
 an article in a blog showing my participation in [...]
 / a directory publishing my contact details / etc.

 But this content is: inaccurate / obsolete /
 extreme / published without my knowledge /
 solely connected with my private life / etc.»

 If there has been a negative impact on your
- private or professional life due to these results, specify it.
- **3** Attach an identity document



Deadline

The search engine has **one month** to reply but the request
can be processed in a few
days.



In the event of refusal

You can refer the matter to the CNIL via its online complaint form.

You can also take the matter to court in order to have the facts checked and the necessary measures taken
